Traffic/Misdemeanor Amnesty Program

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen is offering a one-time amnesty program to provide relief to qualified individuals who have found themselves in default of a court-ordered obligation because they have unpaid fines for traffic and non traffic violations. Encouraging payment of old debt that has remained unpaid will allow Municipal Court to resolve older delinquent cases and focus limited resources on collecting on more recent cases.

The amnesty program provides participants with an opportunity to have court staff process applications for reductions of fines and release of driver's license suspensions. Participation in the amnesty program does not entitle an individual to appear before a judicial officer or reopen their case.

The one-time amnesty program shall operate from October 19, 2015 through October 23, 2015. All fines must be paid in full no time payments.
